Extract from G. O. No. 2485-Fish/C-VI/4M-22/87(Pt.I) dt.3.12.97.

Matters regarding transfer and posting and duties and responsibilities of F.E.Cs. and A.F.Cs. were also under consideration of the Government in the Fisheries Department for sometime. After careful consideration it has now been decided that :-

- Henceforth, transfer with drawal of F.E.Os/A.F.Os should require Departmental approval and Diractor of Fisheries, West Bengal is required to submit nacessary proposals to the Gevt. for
- No.F.E.O./A.F.O. should remain posted in one district for more than sis Years.
- All F.E.Os/A.F.Os excepting those who have only 10(ten)Years' service left for retirement on superannuation, should be required to have atleast one posting of atleast 3(three)years duration, in North Bengal, Malda, Dakshin Dinajpur, Uttar Dinajpur, Jalpaiguri, Cooch Behar and Darjeeling.
- Regarding duty chart of F.E.D.s/A.F.Os in Blocks, Fishery work should get top priority and in no case F.E.Os/A.F.Os should be allowed to disregard their own departmental works. Performance of extra-departmental work by the F.E.O/A.F.O in the Bloks shouldrequire due approval of the concerned A.D.F.
- F.E.Os/A.F.Os posted in the Blocks should submit monthly report of their performance to the respective A.D.Fs while writing A.Cs of F.E.Os/A.F.Os such performance reports should be taken into consideration on by the Reporting Office i.e. the A.D.F.

The Zonal D.D.Fs should serutinise such reports quarterly and submit his comments on the performance of F.E.Ds/A.F.Ds to the Director of Fisheries, West Bengal with a copy to the Departmene in a confidential cover.
