Sub : Transfer policy in respect of officers of
W.B.J.F.S. Grade-II under Dte. of Fisheries, W.B.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to your memo No. Estt.-429 dt. 26.4.93 on the subject cited above and to inform you that a proposal for formulating a transfer policy in respect of officers of West Bengal Junior Fisheries Service, Gr. II (W.B.J.F.S.-II) has been under consideration of this Deptt. for sometime past. After careful consideration of the matter I am directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to formulate the following transfer policy decisions, in respect of the officers of W.B.J.F.S. Gr.-II for taking necessary action with immediate effect from your end :-

- 1) Districts like Calcutta, North 24-Parganas, South 24-Parganas, South-24-Parganas, Burdwan, Hooghly, Howrah and Nadia may be classified as A-category districts, Districts like Birbhum, Murshidabad, Bankura, Midnapore East and Midnapore West may be classified as B-Category districts and the rest, i.e. Purulia, Malda, Dakshin Dinajpur, Uttar Dinajpur, Cooch Behar, Jalpaiguri and Darjeeling may be classified as C-category districts.
- 2) Every Fishery Officer at the initial stage of his service career shall serve in the Block of C-category districts at least for 4 years.
- 3) In general, tenure of officers in each category station will be for at least 4 (four) years and a maximum period of 5 (five) years.
- 4) After posting at the initial stage of one's career, as referred to above, is completed, at the time of second posting, distance from home district of the officer concerned may be taken into consideration at the time of his second posting, provided suitable vacancies exist for accommodating him/her.
- 5) Posting on deputation will be made following principle of seniority-cum-aptitude, experience and performance in blocks. Every willing and suitable officer may be considered for posting on deputation in P.F.D.A. or other agency or corporation for sometime before his retirement, if there are vacancies for such posting at that time.
- 6) Transfer order will normally be issued at the end of each academic year except in emergent cases.
- 7) Officer after having served two years outside his home district may be considered for posting in the category of districts where his home district is situated.
- 8) Under special circumstances posting may be made by the Director of Fisheries in deviation of aforesaid policy. The Director of Fisheries also will reserve the right to transfer any officer any where any time on administrative ground and in the interest of public service.
