Sir, I am directed to invite a reference to your memo No. Estt. -429 dt. 26.4.93 on the subject cited above and to inform you that a proposal for formulating a transfer policy in respect of officers of West Bengal Junior Pisherles Service, Gr. II (W.E.J.F.S.-II) has been under consideration of this Deptt. for sometime past. After careful consideration of the matter I am directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to formulate the following transfer policy decisions, in respect of the officers of W.B.J.F.S. Gr.-II for taking necessary action with immediate effect from your end :-1) Districts like Calcutta, North 24-Parganas, South 24-Parganas, South-24-Parganas, South-24-Parganas, Eurowen, Nooshly, Nowrah and Nadia may be chasalfled as A-category districts, Districts like Birbhum, Murshidabad, Bantura, Midnavore ant and Midnapore West may be classified as U-Category districts and the rest, i.e. Purulia, Malda, Dakanin Dinappur, Uttor Dinappur, Couch Behor, Jalpaiguri and Darjeeling may be classified as C-cateory districts. 2) Every Fishery Officer at the initial stage of his service career shall serve in the Black of G-entegory districts at least for 4 years. 3) In general, tenure of officers in each category station will be for at least 4 (four) years and a maximum period of 5 (five) years. 4) After posting at the initial stage of one's career, as referred to above, is completed, at the time of second posting, distance from home district of the officer concerned may be taken time consideration at the time of his concerned may be taken time consideration at the time of his concerned may be taken time consideration. deration at the time of his second posting, provided suitable vacancles exist for accommodating him/her. 5) Posting on deputation will be made following principle of senioritycum-aptitude, experience and performance in blocks. Every willing and suitable officer may be considered for posting an deputation in F.F.D.A. or other agency or corporation for sometime before his retirement, if there are vacancies for such posting at that time. 6) Transfer order will normally be issued at the end of each academic 7) Officer efter having served two terms outside his home district may be considered for nosting in the entegory of districts where his year except in emergent cases.
